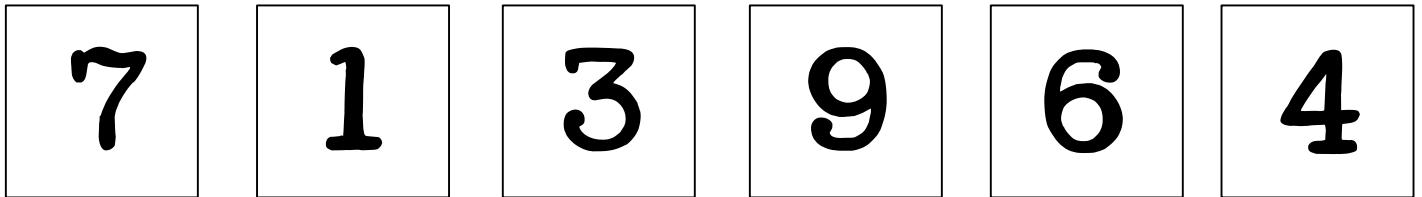
Option 1

- Store the numbers on the bottom of each counting page.

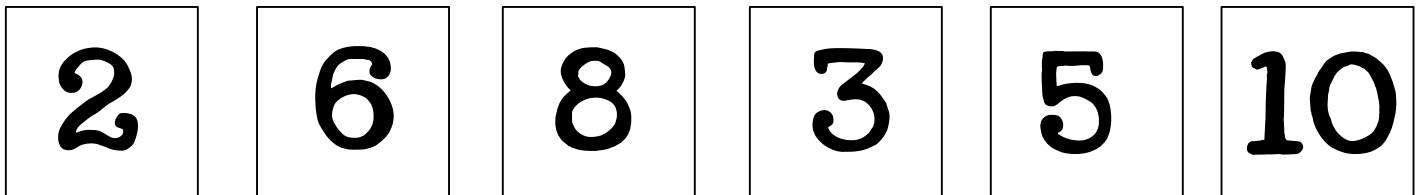

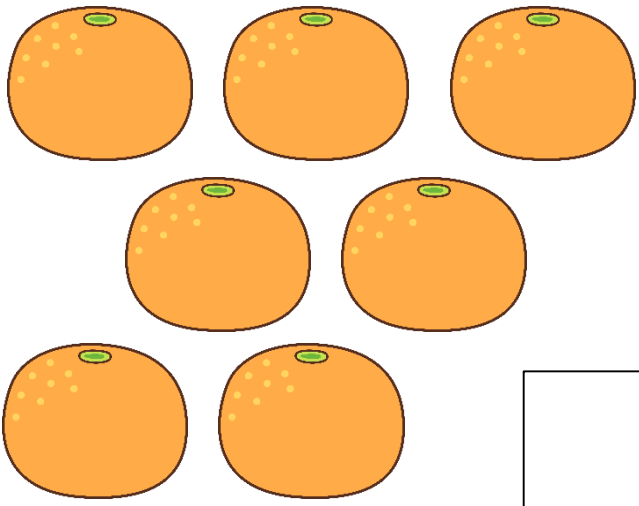
- Create a File Folder activity. Place one sheet on each side of the file folder.

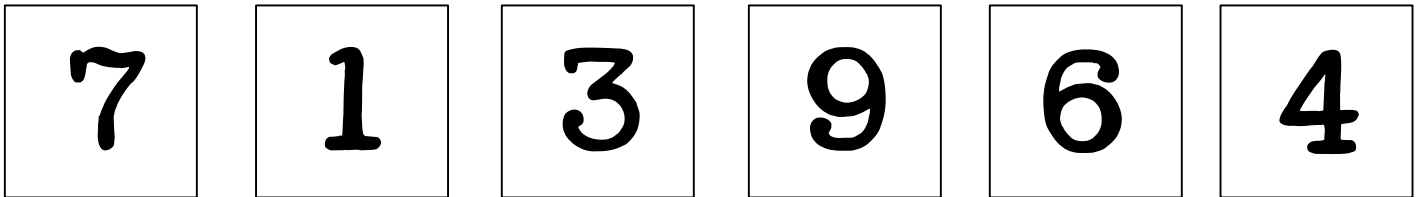
Option 1
