	Unit Focus Topics	Unit Details
Unit 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Uppercase Letter Id & Writing- Food Vocabulary	The goal of this unit is to master uppercase letters through legible and correct letter formation. This unit also focuses on letter identification. The food vocabulary included in this unit is chicken, milk, cheese, carrot, lettuce, apple, banana, eggs, bread, burger, pizza, and french fries. This unit teaches the identification of the images of these words as well as works on the written names of items.
Unit 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Lowercase Letter Writing- Match Lowercase to Uppercase Letters- Animal Vocabulary	The goal of this unit is to master lowercase letters through legible and correct letter formation. This unit also focuses on matching lowercase to uppercase letters. The animal vocabulary included in this unit is dog, cat, duck, turtle, bird, snake, and fish. This unit teaches the identification of the images of these words as well as works on the written names of items.
Unit 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Colors- Clothing Vocabulary	The goal of this unit is to master color identification. Students will work on matching the color to the color word and following directions using colors. This unit's clothing vocabulary includes: shorts, dress, hat, pants, socks, shirt, sweatshirt, and shoes. This unit teaches the identification of the images of these words as well as works on the written names of items.
Unit 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Big and Little- Sports Vocabulary	The goal of this unit is to master identification and comprehension of the attributes big and small. These concepts will be worked on in both isolation and in discrimination to ensure mastery. The sport vocabulary included in this unit is soccer, trophy, baseball, basketball, medals, football, volleyball, and bowling. This unit teaches the identification of the images of these words as well as works on the written names of items.

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Unit 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Associations- Household Vocabulary	The goal of this unit is to master associating similar items. Association is an essential skill that leads to nonidentical matching, categorizing, and more advanced discrimination skills. The household vocabulary included in this unit is door, window, bed, chair, toilet, fridge, tv, and oven. This unit teaches the identification of the images of these words as well as works on the written names of items.
Unit 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Categorize- Community Vocabulary	The goal of this unit is to master categorizing items. The concept of categorization is focused on the categories of animals, food, vehicles, and plants. The community vocabulary included in this unit is police station, house, park, pool, zoo, bridge, hospital, and grocery store. This unit teaches the identification of the images of these words as well as works on the written names of items.
Unit 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Identify by Function- School Supply Vocabulary	The goal of this unit is to master identification of items based on the functions of write, drive, read, and sit on. This unit will focus on comprehension of these concepts through basic sorting and identification tasks. The school supply vocabulary included in this unit is markers, pencil, scissors, notebook, glue, crayons, paint, and eraser. This unit teaches the identification of the images of these words as well as works on the written names of items.
Unit 8	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Identify by Feature- Transportation Vocabulary	The goal of this unit is to master identification of items based on the features of tail, window, wheel, and feet. This unit will focus on comprehension of these concepts through basic sorting and identification tasks. The transportation vocabulary included in this unit is boat, bike, motorcycle, van, taxi, car, train, and airplane. This unit teaches the identification of the images of these words as well as works on the written names of items.
