The Executive Functions Masterclass teaches participants to utilize a variety of evidence-based practices cited by The National Standards Project (2009, 2015) and The National Clearing House on Autism Evidence and Practice (2020) including:

- Modeling
- Prompting
- Reinforcement
- Visual Supports
- Self Management
- Antecedent Based Interventions
- Task Analysis

The strategies taught in the Executive Functions Masterclass are rooted in the science of Applied Behavior Analysis. These strategies are based on the most current research in the field. These additional strategies include Behavior Skills Training, Prompt Fading, Differential Reinforcement, Behavior Contingency Maps, and Schedules.

These evidence-based strategies are reinforced every step of the way as Sasha takes participants through assessment of executive function skills, intervention planning and teaching, as well as data collection and staff training.
